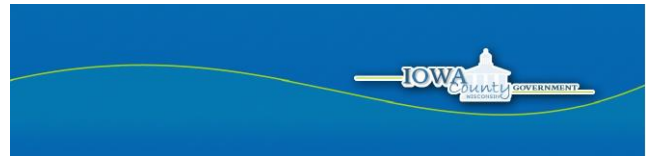

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Iowa County Health Department is working with your school district to provide influenza (flu) vaccine at your school this fall. Flu shots will be provided for school-age children (4 years through 18 years old) by the Iowa County Health Department and the Wisconsin Immunization Program as part of a mass immunization exercise.

- Vaccines are **FREE** for all students, no insurance information is needed
- Flu vaccine will be injectable only

If you would like to have your child vaccinated at school, please do the following:

1. Read the Vaccine Information Statement (VIS) regarding the influenza (flu) vaccine
2. Complete the Vaccine Administration Record Consent Form.
3. Return the Consent Form to the school by **Wednesday, October 18.**

If you do not want your child vaccinated at school there is no need to return this form.
