- Flu vaccine will be injectable only

- 1. Read the Vaccine Information Statement (VIS) regarding the influenza (flu) vaccine
- 2. Complete the Vaccine Administration Record Consent Form.
- 3. Return the Consent Form to the school by Wednesday, October 18.

If you do not want your child vaccinated at school there is no need to return this form.
